October

The top prize was to be paid for from the raffle proceeds. On behalf of the Student Council and 127Hours team, Ms

Veleva bought it from emag.bg on Black Friday at a great discount price of BGN 283.33 (VAT excl)

We prepared a sponsorship request letter and the students from 11.V and 12.V made the round of the food outlets in the area of the school. They kindly contributed a total of 60 consolation prizes in the form of snacks and hot beverages.

December

Designing, printing, and distributing the raffle tickets

School Principal Mr. Lazarov helped us save 50 lv in color printing costs and printed out 50 pages or a total of 800 raffle tickets. The drawing date was set for December 21st, during the school Christmas Concert, and over the preceding 10 days, students from the 127Hours team and the Student Council managed to sell a total of 712 tickets.
